***Make every effort to attend Sweden Day on June 24, 2017 when Scholarships will be awarded. Applicants may be asked to read his/her essay at the event. If you cannot attend, please send a representative.**

Awards are granted based solely on the candidate's application and essay. All decisions by the judges and the Sweden Day Committee are final. Awards can be made to the individual or jointly to the individual and the school of planned study.
