Include school activities, hobbies, honors, special interests, involvement in organizations, Swedish-related interests and associations, and any other pertinent information that will give the judges an idea of who you are. Portions of your essay will be read aloud to the audience during the "Parade of Contestants." Please write your essay in first person (i.e., I was born...). The essay is a very important part of the judging.**
- 3) Plan to arrive at Manhem Club between 11:30 a.m. and no later than 12 p.m.** to register and check in. Interviews will start promptly at 12:30 p.m. You may enjoy the event when you aren't involved in MSD activities.
- 4) Please dress appropriately but comfortably during the day.** The "Parade of Contestants" will start at approximately 5:00 p.m. For this portion of the contest, we suggest a formal dress or Swedish Costume.
